THE ROLE OF SPACE FLIGHT ATTENDANTS IN LARGE, LONG-DURATION SPACE TRAVEL

**Abstract**

Our business is to train space flight attendants to accompany passengers who travel on commercial spaceships and to provide full support for the entire journey, including before and after the space trip, mainly for Japanese customers.

The paper presented at the 2020-2021 IAC discussed the support for short-range space travels by small spacecrafts and the future prospects of space flight attendants. In this paper, we will discuss the role of space flight attendant for long-range and large spacecrafts.

The value and content of support based on Japanese characteristics, tour services, support for passengers' needs and physical and mental care unique to long-duration space travel, entertainment and learning, and other various roles played by space flight attendants will be discussed.
